Sealed Bids are requested by the Borough of Glen Osborne. Bids will be received by the Borough's Consulting Engineer, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc., at 950 Fifth Avenue, Coraopolis, PA 15108 until 3:00 P.M. prevailing time, Thursday, March 11, 2021, for the 2021 Sanitary Sewer Lining. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc.'s office is closed to the public. Perspective bidders may mail their bids to or drop them off at a designated box in the lobby at NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc.

Bids will be opened with witnesses and publicly read aloud VIA TELECONFERENCE after the closing time for receipt of Bids. All registered bidders will be provided Zoom Meeting ID and Password prior to the bid opening date and will be permitted to view the bid opening.

Copies of the Bid Documents may be obtained by appointment only at the office of NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc., 412-262-3970, 950 Fifth Avenue, Coraopolis, Pennsylvania 15108, upon payment of a non-refundable sum of \$50.00 or by mail upon payment of a non-refundable sum of \$60.00. Checks are to be made payable to NIRA Consulting Engineers, Inc. Bids must be submitted on the forms provided, and completed in strict accordance with the instructions provided. Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, in the form of a Certified Check or Corporate Surety Bid Bond, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the Bid Proposal made in the favor of the Borough of Glen Osborne. Only documents obtained directly from the Engineer will be valid at bid opening.

A Performance Bond, Labor and Material Payment Bond, and Maintenance Bond in the amounts specified within the Contract Documents will be required of the successful Bidder.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act 442. The Prevailing Wage Scale is included in these Specifications.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the Provisions of the Public Works Employment Verification Act (PWEVA).

Adherence to Instructions to Bidders is required.

No Bid or any part thereof shall be withdrawn by Bidder for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the Bid Opening.

The right is reserved by the Owner to reject any or all Bids or parts of bids and to waive technical defects in any Bid.

PROJECT SCOPE

The project generally includes the cured-in-place lining of approximately 670 linear feet of existing 8 inch vitrified clay pipe, post-lining lateral cut-outs, cut back of intruding laterals, pre-lining pipe cleaning including root cutting, pre and post lining cleaning and CCTV inspections, CCTV inspection of approximately 182 linear feet of existing 8 inch vitrified clay pipe, traffic control, and bypass pumping of sewage flows.
